

PUTTING YOU IN THE PICTURE



"Combating corruption" was the theme of this week's "Al Amen" programme, organised by the Media Directorate at the Interior Ministry, in co-operation with Bahrain Radio. A spokesman for the general directorate of economic and electronic security and anti-corruption Major Bassem Al Miraj said that a committee of experts is being formed. He defined the concept of "corruption" as the act of "abusing government positions for personal profit," explaining that material gains and lack of internal auditing in some institutions are behind the phenomenon. Major Al Miraj said that the number of corruption cases decreased from 19 last year to only six this year, which, he said, mostly involved bribery. He announced that a confidential hotline (992) "Nazaha" (transparency) has been put at the disposal of citizens to complain about bribery, embezzlement and abuse of power. Meanwhile, the directorate for combating administrative corruption at the general directorate for combating security and economic corruption, in co-operation with community police, conducted an awareness campaign on corruption in the five governorates, in addition to the airport and King Fahad causeway.
